

Angry Birds Live Game

Many people have seen pictures of our angry birds live Game and wanted more info. Below are some pictures of the game and how we play it.

You must have a large area to play this game. We place 2 sling shot devices (Pictures Below) in the center of the stage back to back so 2 people can compete against each other. This is better than taking turns when playing an up front or a stage game with an audience. Each person gets 5 birds (Pics Below) that they can fire toward Pigs on cardboard bricks that are on card tables (Pics Below) they have one minute to see who can get the most pigs off the table. You will need 2 people to be runners to bring the birds back to the shooters unless you buy a ton of birds which is very costly.

The table with the pigs needs to be at least 10 feet or more from the sling shots. Most kids over shoot and don't hit any pigs or very few pigs. We found a techno version of the angry bird's music on YouTube and made our own video to play in the background while the kids are playing to add momentum. The slings are made from 2 inch PVC pipes and latex water balloon launchers on a Diamond plat base with a Pipe to hold the PVC Sling shot that we had a local welder make for us. The kids stand on the Diamond Plate bases to keep the sling shots from tipping over or falling.

You can buy the stuffed birds and pigs off Amazon or Ebay. The cardboard bricks should be found at most toy stores or online somewhere.
